Luke 6:27-38

Bible Verse "Do for others just what you want them to do for you."- Luke 6:31

The Story: Jesus says to the crowd: Love your enemies. Show your best side rather than your worst to those who hate you. If someone is mean to you, pray for that person. If someone slaps you, let them. If someone takes your coat, ask if they want your shirt too. If someone takes advantage of you, remember that you are called to help others. No more payback. Live generously. If you only love those who love you, or help those who help you why are you special? Anyone can do that. Again, I say love your enemies, help others, and give without expecting anything. Then, I promise you, you will find satisfaction. Live your life the way God does for us; with kindness, generosity, and mercy even when we are terrible. Do for others what you want them to do for you. And, unless you want people to judge you, complain about you, or kick you when you are down, don't do that to others. Be kind and forgiving to others and life will be easier. When you give, you will get back more with a blessing. Giving, not getting is God's way.

Measurement Words: dash - sprinkle - cup - touch - teaspoon - tablespoon - handful

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
The Steps: pour - mix - knead - combine - stir - mold
